#### How far was Jesus' walk to Calvary?

Jesus' path to Calvary is known as the Via Dolorossa or "Way of Sorrows." This road from the Praetorium (the Roman judgement hall) to Calvary, the hill that was the site of the crucifixion, is about 650 yard long – little more than 1/3 of a mile. Its surface would have been very rough and the carrying of a heavy beam – after the scourging at the pillar – would have been exceedingly difficult for Jesus. Over the centuries, millions of people have walked this path in devotion to the Passion. If you go to Jerusalem, daily pilgrimages are made from the Monastery of the Flagellation to Calvary.
