### How can we ask for Christ's mercy in the midst of our failings?

Dismas is the good thief who hung next to Christ and defended Christ against the unrepentant thief. Unrepentant thief was taunting and mocking Christ even during his own agony, moment before death. But Dismas on the other hand, sees Christ hanging on the Cross next to him, acknowledges that Dismas himself is worthy of the Cross that he bears, that he deserves that. But the Christ is innocent. So he defends Him and then looks into the eyes of Christ, hanging next to him on the Cross and says “Jesus, remember me when you come into your kingdom.” Prayer that we pray every time before receiving Holy Communion. And Jesus, right there, in that moment “canonizes” Dismas. He tells him, that he will this day be with Him in paradise. And that is literally what canonization is, a guarantee of heaven. Of course the names of Dismas and Gestas do not appear in the Gospels. It is the names that tradition gives to these two thieves. In the early church these two figures captivated the minds and imaginations in the early Christians. *Today, you can be like St. Dismas, “hanging on your own cross.”* Make an eye contact with Jesus...

World Marriage Day takes place on February 9, 2025. World Marriage Day is an observance sponsored by the Catholic Marriage Encounter movement observed on the second Sunday of February each year. Its purpose is declared to be “World Marriage Day honors husband and wife as the foundation of the family, the basic unit of society.
