ST. ANDREW'S PENCE COLLECTION:

Traditionally on or around Feast of St. Andrew, the first called Apostle (November 30) our parishes in the entire Ukrainian Catholic Church have a special collection for needs of pastoral ministry of His Beatitude Sviatoslav. St. Andrew's Pence Collection unites us in solidarity with His Beatitude Sviatoslav, Father and Head of the Ukrainian Catholic Church and his works of charity to those in need. Your generosity allows His Beatitude Sviatoslav to respond to our suffering brothers and sisters in the world. The purpose of St. Andrew's Pence Collection is to provide Patriarch Sviatoslav with the financial means to respond to those who are suffering as a result of war, oppression, and natural disaster, and help our faithful in the Eastern Ukraine, Siberia and Kazakhstan. Your help is needed especially this year, because of the suffering and loss of life in Ukraine brought about by the Russian invasion; the needs of the millions of misplaced people in Ukraine and abroad -- primarily women and children.

FEAST OF THE ENTRANCE OF THE MOTHER OF GOD INTO THE TEMPLE:

In our Byzantine tradition, on November 21st, we celebrate the Feast of the Entrance of the Mother of God into the Temple. This event is not found in the Scripture. It is found in the apocryphal Protoevangelium of James.

Apocryphal writings are very ancient Christian writings that didn't make it into the collection of books that form the Bible. James says that Joachim and Ann brought Mary to the temple to be presented to the high priest, at the age of three. There she was to be raised among the virgins consecrated to God's service until the time to get married.

As we celebrate this feast of Mary, who entered into the Temple to become herself the temple of the Lord, we are reminded that we are also living temples of God, as St. Paul says in his second letter to the Corinthians.

We praise Mary, the Living Tabernacle, who carried Christ within her and shared him with the world, and ask her to help us live like living temples of God and shared Christ with others.
