VENERATION OF THE HOLY CROSS

On September 14th, we celebrate the Feast of the Exaltation of the Precious and Life-Giving Cross and we will continue venerating the cross during the week. At the beginning and at the end of all Divine Liturgies we will sing the hymn to the cross: "To your cross, O Master, we bow in veneration, and we glorify your holy resurrection." This hymn is accompanied by a full prostration to the ground. We ask all parishioners who are physically capable, to honor the precious and lifegiving cross, by prostrating themselves as we sing this hymn. As a sign of respect and veneration, we approach the tetrapod and honor the cross with a kiss.

Meditation 19:

The Last Supper represents the culmination of Christ's entire life. It is not only the anticipation of his sacrifice which will be rendered on the Cross, but also the synthesis of a life offered for the salvation of the whole of humanity. Therefore, it is not enough to state that Jesus is present in the Eucharist, but one must see in it the presence of a life given and partake in it. When we take and eat that Bread, we are associated into the life of Jesus, we enter into communion with Him, we commit to achieve communion among ourselves, to transform our life into a gift, especially to the poorest.

We consist of parishioners from St. Francis de Sales, Holy Ghost, and St. Paul's. We have received our first \$100 donation which has allowed us to open a working Ohio Catholic Credit Union account.
