Meditation #47:

The Eucharist is the culmination of Jesus' entire life, which was a single act of love toward the Father and brothers and sisters. There too, as with the miracle of the multiplication of the loaves, Jesus took the bread in his hands, raised a prayer of blessing to the Father, broke the bread and gave it to his disciples; and he did the same with the cup of wine. But in that moment, on the eve of his Passion, with that gesture, he wished to leave the Testament of his new and eternal Covenant, a perpetual memorial of the Paschal Mystery of his death and resurrection.

THE PROTECTING VEIL OF THE MOTHER OF GOD

Each year on October 1st, the Church celebrates a most beautiful feast called the "Protection of the Mother of God." Historically, this feast commemorates an event in 911 AD when the Mother of God, in response to the fervent prayers of the faithful gathered in the Church of Blancher-nae, appeared in a vision to extend her veil over the city of Constantinople to protect it from foreign invasion. Over the years, the Mother of God has been seen in numerous other visions to extend her protecting veil over her faithful children.

Consequently, this feast day has been not only preserved on our calendar, but has come to be one of the most cherished feasts in the lives of Eastern Christians because it reminds us of protection we receive from the Mother of God. As we are reminded by the saints, "no one who has ever sought the intercession of the Most Holy Virgin has even gone unaided!" O Holy Mother of God, pray for us!
